



Lower Income Students in Michigan Behind Peers in Other States


Grade 4 – NAEP Reading (2011)

Grade 8 – NAEP Math (2011)








Percentage of Latino Students Meeting or Exceeding State Standards By District


Percentage of African American Students Meeting or Exceeding State Standards By District 2010 Grade 4 Reading MEAP


Percentage of African American Students Meeting or Exceeding State Standards By District


Percentage of African American Students Meeting or Exceeding State Standards By District 2010 Grade 4 Reading MEAP



Percentage of African American Students Meeting or **Exceeding State Standards By District**






