

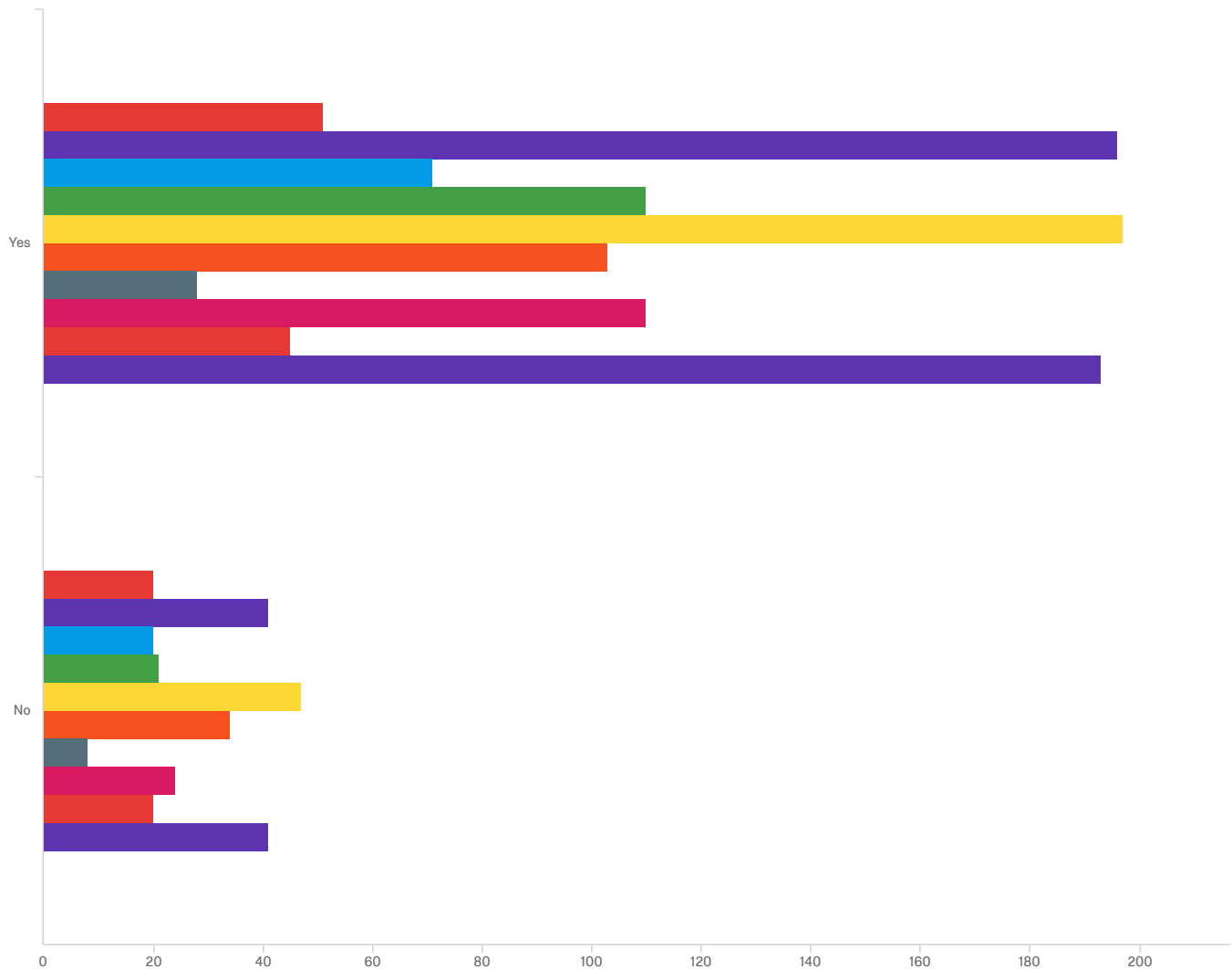

the 2018 Michigan elections? Choose four.

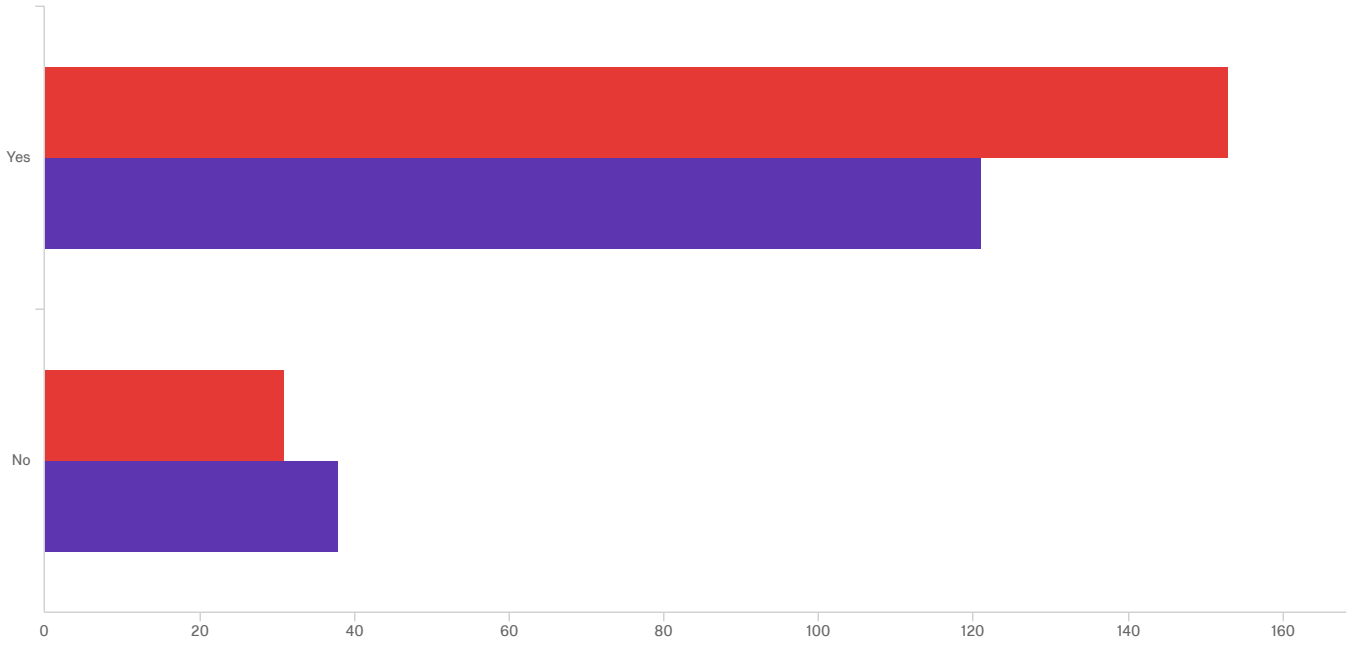

Volunteer literacy tutor

I plan to volunteer with Voters, not Politicians.

I volunteer at the Baldwin Center in Pontiac which provides food, clothing, education and other services to the poor and underserved in Pontiac.

I've volunteered with Amnesty International to collect petition signatures and I've volunteered the Michigan Nature Association

Save Lake St.Clair is an organization I have volunteered for and help to promote.

I volunteer with Citizens' Climate Lobby and in that capacity I am liaison to Rep. Lawrence and Senator Peters. I also volunteer with Voters Not Politicians

I'm a member of MOMS Demand Action for Gun Sense in America. I'm surprised to not see gun sense legislature on your list. This is an issue I am voting about. My vote will not go to NRA politicians.

I direct a non-profit dedicated to increasing the rate of participation by all eligible (not just registered) voters... at the polls every year on General Election Day. A target rate of 75% is the goal.

I feel like the growth of the metro area will be stunted without education and improvements to the infrastructure. I volunteer at my local high school with improvement projects as well as tutoring in reading. (Lincoln High in Ypsi)

I am a special education teacher and member of my union. As such, I advocate daily for my students' needs, the state of our educational system, and how teachers are treated, respected, and compensated.

In both 2016 and 2017 I ran my fiancée's campaign against Brian Banks and Tenisha Yancey, both convicted felons who had been less than transparent about their past transgressions. I continue that work through "Veterans for Ethical Government" PAC, which will be active in both Mr. Banks Senate race, as well as Miss Yancey's House race.

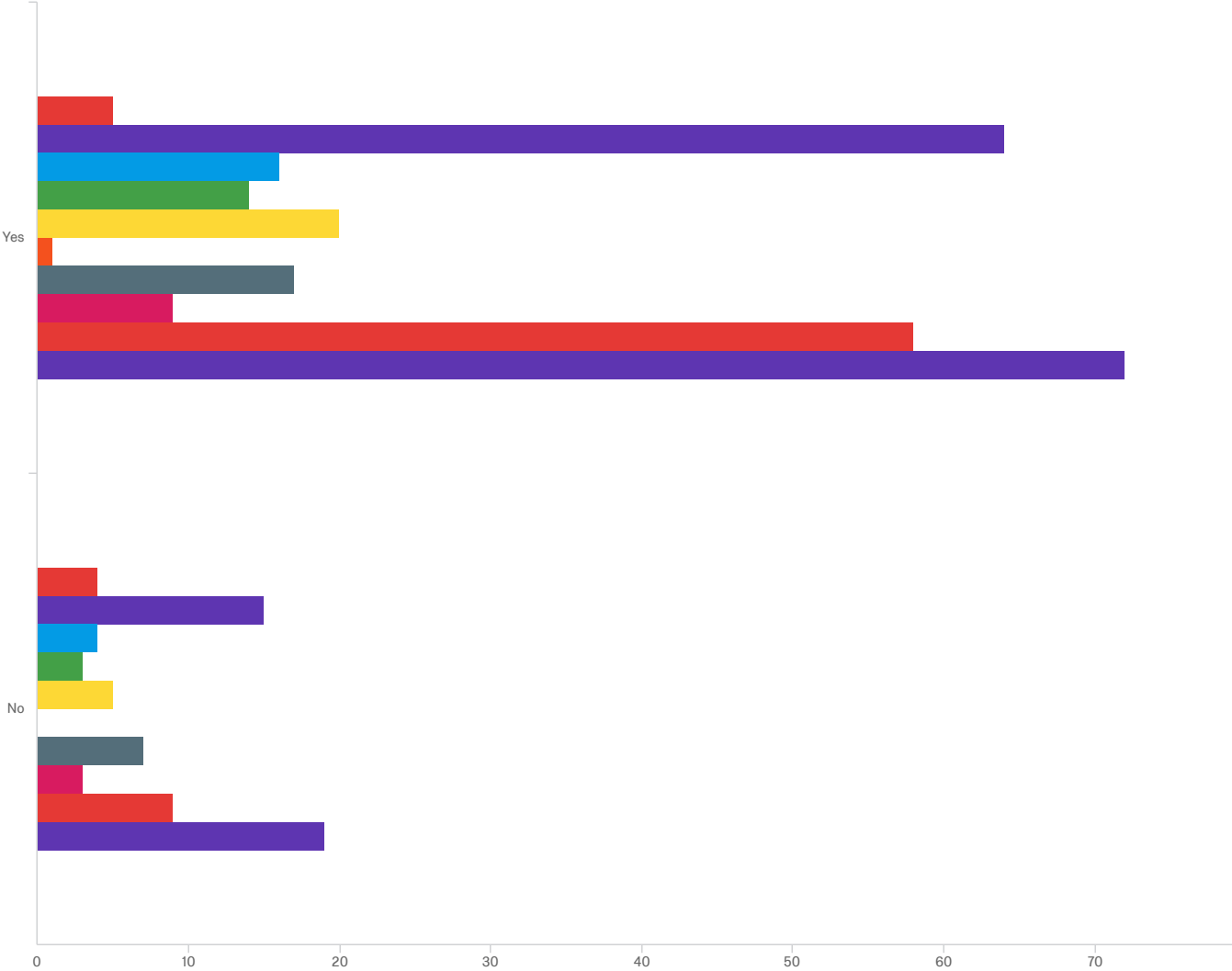

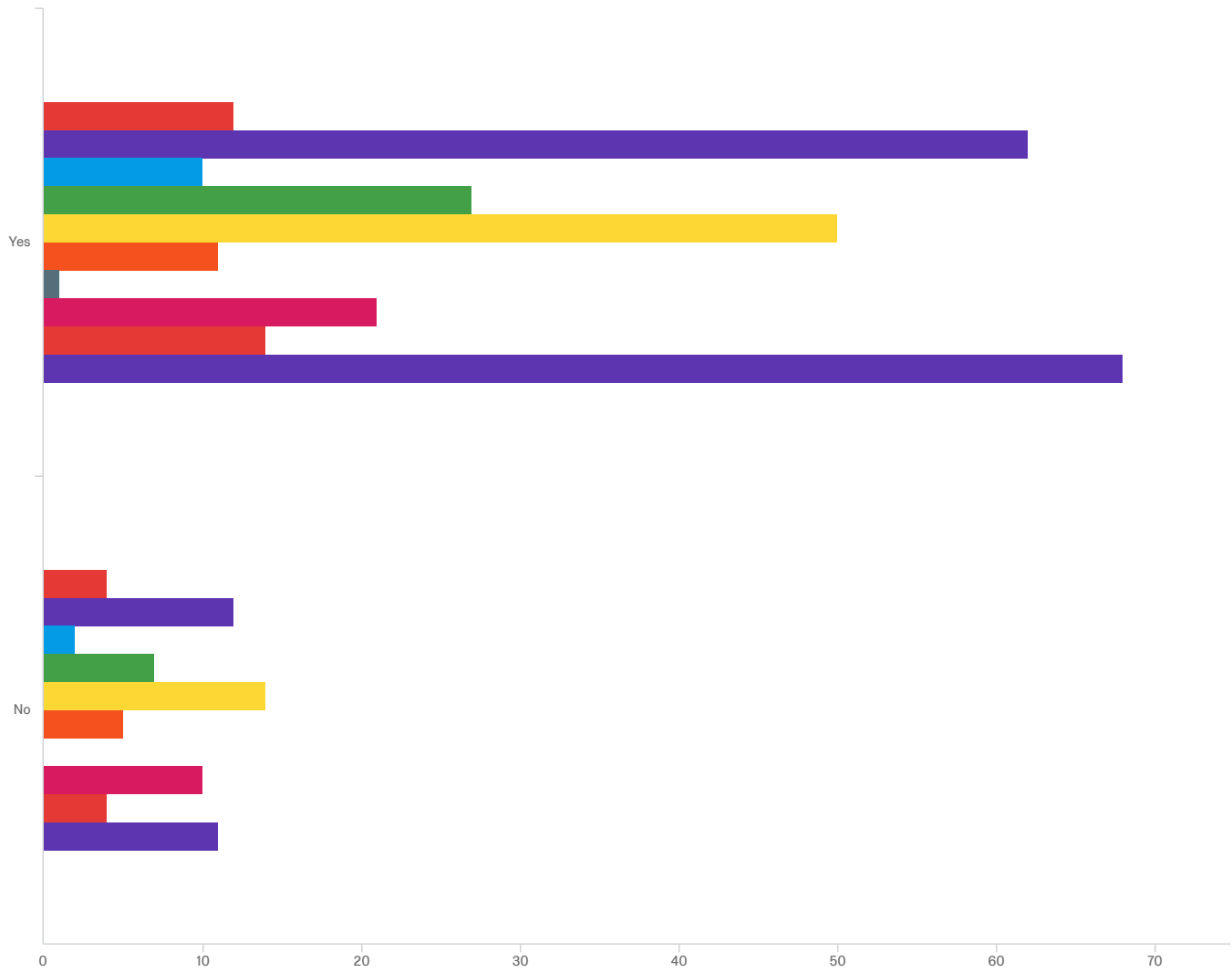

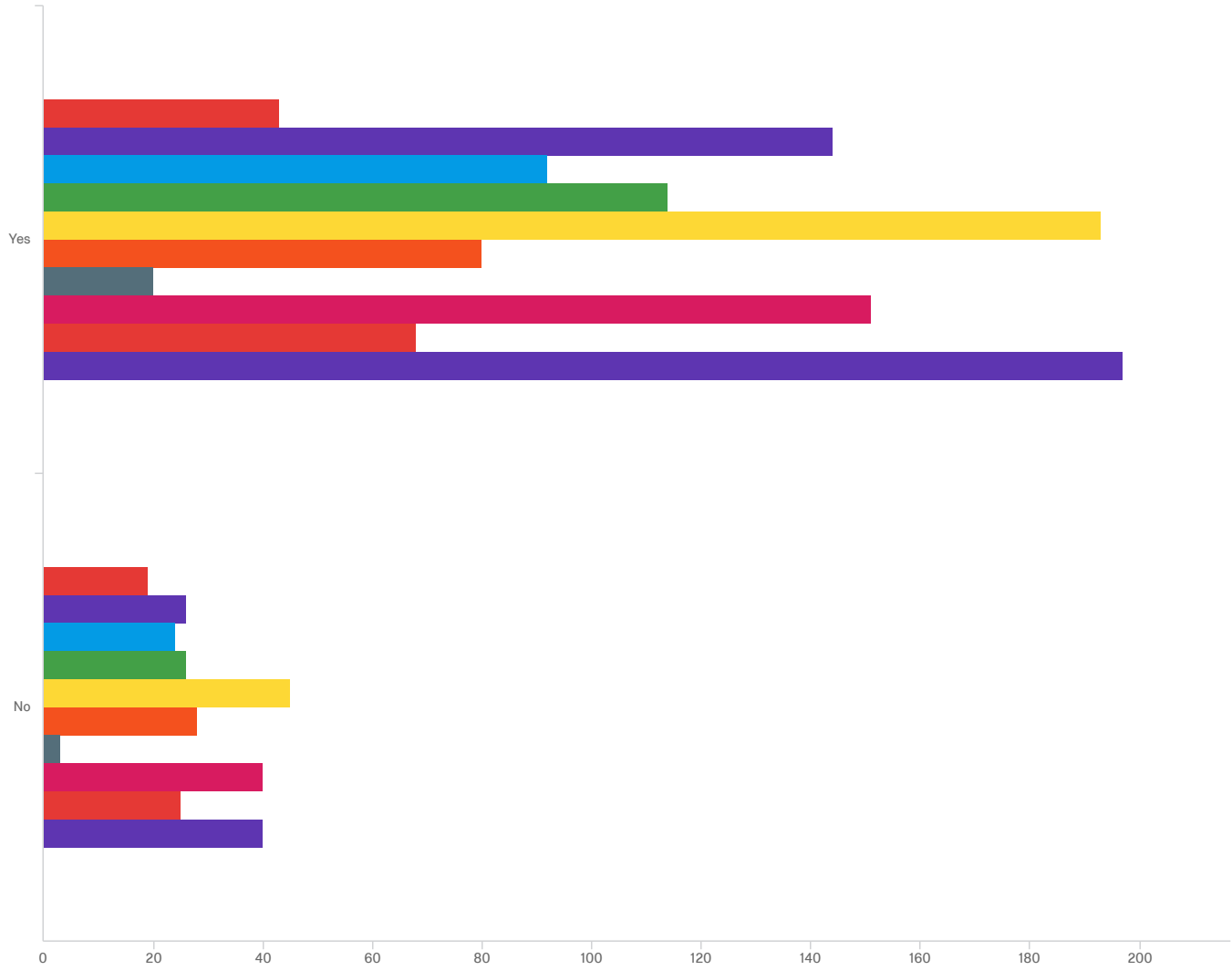
### Q3 - Of these issues which will impact how you vote in the 2018 Michigan elections?

Q6 - Which of these issues do you talk about most at the dinner table with family and friends? Choose four.



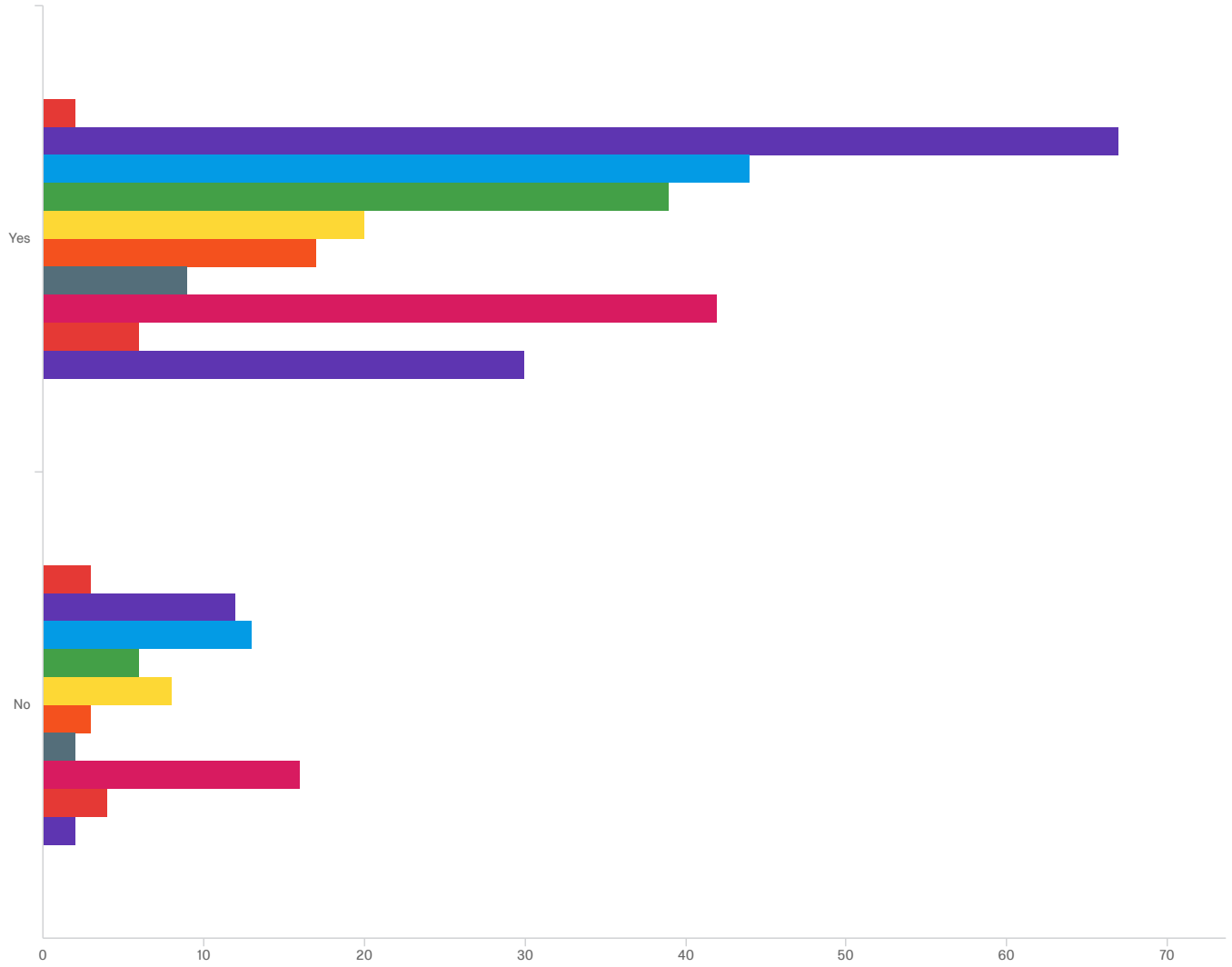

Q14 - Of your choices which of these issues which do you feel is covered least by the media?



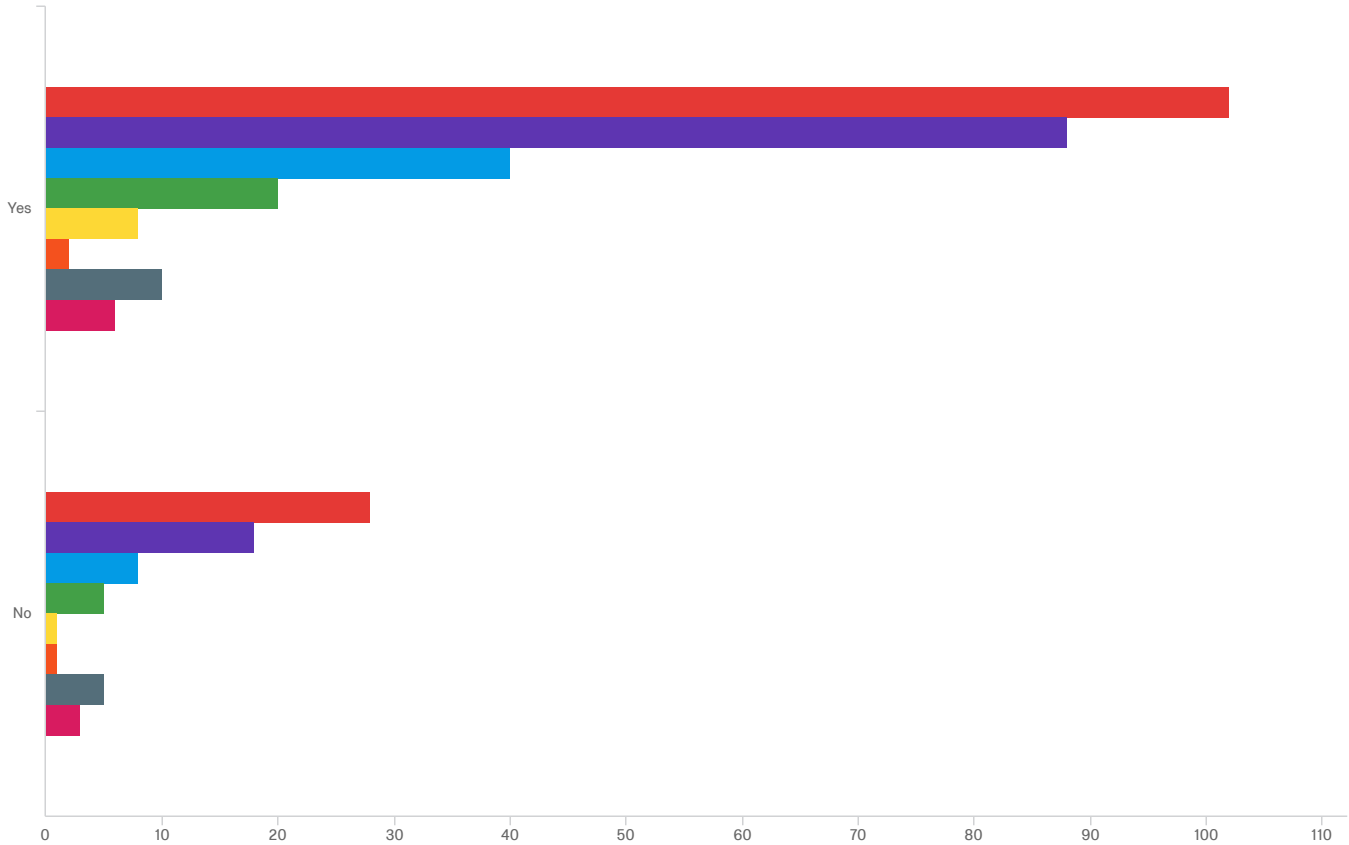

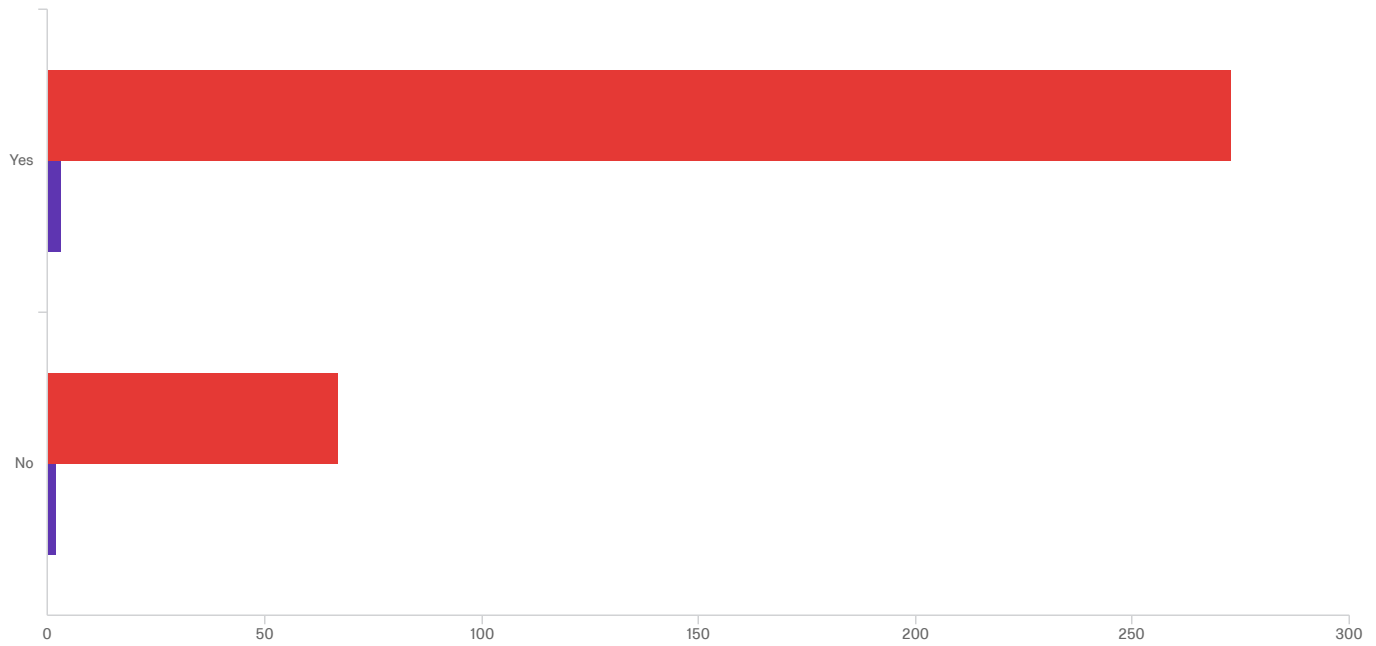
